I. **Welcome** The meeting was called to order at 7:30 by Connie Jacobs. There were 8 Board members in attendance for a total of 21 people in attendance of the meeting. There were many new faces so each person introduced themselves to the group in attendance.

II. **Determine Quorum** A quorum was met.

III. **Treasurer's Report: Ken Azevedo**

- Account Balance: There is a balance of \$ 1628 in the checking account. There are show start up expenses to be paid; ribbons, insurance, etc.

IV. **Committee Reports**

- **Performance Committee: Tammy Azevedo, Chairperson:** The October show is this Sunday. We already have several people pre-registered and we look forward to a great show season.
- **Technology Committee: Tammy Azevedo, Chairperson:** I will have a newsletter to send out the week after the HJ show. We will post it on the mylcha.com website and send it out via constant contact. Norma requested that the HJ prize list posted online be in all black ink because when she printed it the blue numbers did not print out. Kim will be sure to talk this over with Lori.
- **Advertising Committee: Ken Azevedo, Chairperson:** We currently have 7 GOLD advertisers and 2 SILVER. Leslie Terry submitted one additional advertiser in each category. Gold advertising signs will be posted at all shows this season. Signs will be produced as advertising fees are paid.
- **Hunter/Jumper Committee: Kim Breen, Chairperson:** HJ met yesterday and developed a new class list. We will now offer all Marshall & Sterling classes on both days. Members can now earn as many points at our shows as an A rated show. The new class list is "huge" and we are very excited. Lori will have the new class list posted ASAP. Heather suggested that the HJ committee proof read their rules and documents for type-o's due to some confusion. We are expecting a huge turn out at the show and it is suggested that people pre-register and reserve their stalls ASAP.
